

Ham of the Year

Who, as a member of the WVRA, in your opinion, has represented Amateur Radio the best in this year?

This award is, intended to be, given to the most deserving member of the WVRA for the calendar year. To aid in the selection, these suggested requirements might be used. Ham of the Year can be based on, but not required to include, the following. Community Service through WVRA sponsored events. Participation in other WVRA events. Position of responsibility in Amateur Radio (Officer of an organization for hams, repeater and other equipment maintenance, experimentation, net participation or control operator. Helping other hams to setup or maintain their station, mobile or home, antennas, and towers. Elmering or teaching those who wish to become a ham, or to advance in Amateur Radio. On the air operating skills such as polite, helpful and good personality.

Nominations will be accepted on the appropriate form at the January meeting of the WVRA. Nominations sent in should be received on the appropriate form no later than December 21th. The Award Committee will screen nominations from clubs other than the WVRA. If the Award Committee agrees, the committee will nominate the submission.

The Award Committee will screen the nominations and submit three to the WVRA members. All members will be Emailed, or mailed a ballot to be filled out and returned to the WVRA before January 21th.

Any nomination received that is not in compliance with the above criteria and submitted on the official form will be immediately be disqualified and not considered for the award.
