

WVRA Ear Award

A member of the WVRA must make the nomination at the January meeting of the WVRA. The Nominee need not be a member of the WVRA but must be a licensed Amateur Radio Operator.

The Nominee must have had a direct influence on Amateur Radio in Central Wisconsin.

Nomination of a Silent Key is permitted if the person became a Silent Key within the last two callander years, or the Award Committee can accept nomination on individual merit.

The award will be based on Amateur Radio Activities, contributions and Community Service related to Amateur Radio, such as participation in the NTS, Club memberships, Club projects, Club activates, Emergency Services, Elmering, experimentation, Repeater ownership or maintenance of systems, contributions by holding an ARRL position (appointed or elected), or in any way promoted or advanced Amateur Radio. **Community Service must be related to Amateur Radio in some way.**

Nominations will be accepted on the appropriate form at the January meeting of the WVRA. Nominations sent in should be received on the appropriate form no later than December 21th. The Award Committee will screen nominations from clubs other than the WVRA. If the Award Committee agrees, the committee will nominate the submission.

The Award Committee will screen the nominations and submit three to the WVRA members. All members will be Emailed, or mailed a ballot to be filled out and returned to the WVRA before January 21th.

A nomination form will be available on the WVRA web page at wvracub.org or contacting WVRA Board member.

Any nomination received that is not in compliance with the above criteria and submitted on the official for will be immediately be disqualified and not considered for the award.
